JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS Regular Session Emergency Management Operations Center October 15, 2020 6:00 P.M.

The Board met this date in regular session. Present were Chair JT Surles, Commissioners Betsy Barfield, Stephen Fulford, Eugene Hall and Stephen Walker. Also present were County Attorney Scott Shirley and Clerk of Court Kirk Reams.

- 1. Chairman Surles called the meeting order. Commissioner Walker led the invocation and pledge of allegiance.
- 2. Sheriff Mac McNeill presented a check to the Board in the amount of \$23,537.13 for unused budgetary funds. Property Appraiser Angela Gray stated she would be taking her refund check in the amount of \$7,174 to the Clerk's Office the following day.
- 3. Chairman Surles requested that two items be added to the agenda: 4e, the Thompson Valley Road repair; 4f, the Canvassing Board alternate. On motion by Commissioner Walker, seconded by Commissioner Barfield and unanimously carried (4-0, Hall absent), the consent agenda—consisting of the approval of the agenda as amended, General Fund/Transportation Vouchers, BOCC Minutes for the 9/22/2020 and 10/1/2020 Regular Sessions, 9/10/2020 Tentative Budget Hearing, 9/22/2020 Final Budget Hearing, 10/1/2020 Sole Purpose Meeting, 9/22/2020 Special Meeting and Budget Amendment for Sheriff and Property Appraiser—was approved.
- 4. County Attorney Scott Shirley performed the second reading of the Comprehensive Plan Map Change. On motion by Commissioner Barfield, seconded by Commissioner Walker and unanimously carried (4-0, Hall absent), the Board approved the Comprehensive Plan.
- 5. Clerk of Court Kirk Reams introduced the Jefferson County CARES Act item. David Johosky, with GSG, provided an update on the Phase II funding.
- 6. Commissioner Barfield introduced the Broadband RFP discussion. Clerk of Court Kirk Reams opened the one bid that was submitted from CenturyLink. On motion by Commissioner Barfield, seconded by Commissioner Hall and unanimously carried, the Board voted to have the bid from CenturyLink taken to the evaluation committee board before determining how to proceed.
- 7. Chairman Surles introduced the return to open meetings discussion. County Health Department Director Kim Albritton spoke to the Board and stated she would be providing some input and guidance for re-opening the meetings. It was the consensus of the Board to return to open meetings at the Courthouse Annex on November 5th.
- 8. County Coordinator Parrish Barwick provided an update on the Thompson Valley Road issue. He stated there was a wash out on the road that needed attention. Anderson Columbia is already in the vicinity for another project and Mr. Barwick recommended they be utilized in an emergency situation since they were already mobilized in the area. On motion by Commissioner Walker, seconded by Commissioner Hall and unanimously carried, the Board approved moving forward with Anderson Columbia to repair Thompson Valley Road.

- 11. County Coordinator Parrish Barwick stated the County was about to move forward with a new Veterans Affairs employee that we would be sharing with Madison County.
- 12. Chairman Surles commended Sheriff McNeill for his pit maneuver the previous day on Interstate 10 that disabled the reckless driver and prevented further injury/property damage.
- 13. On motion by Commissioner Walker, seconded by Commissioner Hall and unanimously carried, the meeting was adjourned.

PROPOSED CONCEPTS/LANGUAGE IF FUNDS REMAIN AFTER INDIVIDUAL/BUSINESS ASSISTANCE PRE-QUALIFICATION IS COMPLETE

NEW BUSINESSES

The Business Assistance Grant Program will allow approximately 20 new start-up businesses to prequalify for up to four times their average monthly revenues for the last 3 to 6-months they were open to the public up to a maximum of \$15,000 per applicant in grant money to cover normal business expenses, including employee wages, vendor bills, rent, utilities and employee/customer safety costs to help offset the temporary loss of revenue due to COVID-19.

Businesses that can demonstrate a negative financial impact during the period between 3/1/2020 and 12/30/2020 compared to revenues for a 3 to 6 month period when they were not impacted may apply. If this cannot be demonstrated, and the business has proof that they were closed due to a "stay at home order" issued by the State or "quarantine" issued by the Department of Health, a one-time grant of \$3,000 may be awarded.

NON PROFITS

Jefferson County has allocated CARES Act funding to support the on-going work of local non-profits that provide services to mitigate or respond to the current coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. Non-profits may request funds to support Food Assistance Programs or Service Expansion Programs related to COVID-19. In addition, funds may be requested to reimburse costs for unfunded and unbudgeted essential supplies, mortgage/rent, utility, payroll, and/or personal protective equipment. All eligible organizations will be vetted through a grant application process, and all expenses should be appropriately justified. Grants will be disbursed after review and approval of documented expenditures. Examples include:

- Food Assistance,
- Service Expansion,
- Essential supplies,
- Mortgage/Rent Assistance,
- Utility Assistance,
- Payroll Assistance (excluding payroll taxes),

- The organization can provide evidence that they were closed due to a "stay at home order" issued by the State or "quarantine" issued by the Department of Health and had to cancel events or activities that would have otherwise generated a source of revenue.
- The organization can meet the technical requirements of the grant program, including the ability to provide financial records and program validation.

States, including, but not limited to, state government, county, municipality, school district, nonprofit public university or college, single purpose or multipurpose special district, single-purpose special or multipurpose authority, metropolitan or consolidated government, separate legal entity or administrative entity, or any agency of the Federal Government.

"Minor Irregularity" means a variation from the requirements of the Request for Proposal which does not give any Respondent an advantage or benefit not enjoyed by the other Respondents or does not adversely impact the interests of County.

"Respondent" means the entity that submits a Proposal to the Request for Proposal.

"Responsive Respondent" means a Respondent that submits a Proposal that conforms in all material respects to the requirements of the Request for Proposal.

"Responsible Respondent" means an entity that submits a Proposal that shows that they have the capability in all respects to perform fully the Services outlined in the Request for Qualification, and the integrity and reliability that will assure good faith performance.

The study will provide a fact-based management tool and will determine whether property acquisition, and/or improvement to the existing park property, is feasible, reasonable, and economical.

Objectives - Provide fact-based information as a tool to help guide the County's decision making on both moving forward with property acquisition and turning it into a County owned and operated site, and/or identifying additional public use and access improvements to undeveloped areas of the existing park property, in order to expand public access and recreation opportunities at Wacissa River Park and adjacent or nearby lands.

Scope of Work - The feasibility study will provide Jefferson County with the following information:

Part 1 Existing Park:

1. Detailed description of the property identifying all existing structures, parking, permitted

areas for future development, open space, and utilities..

- 2. Identify potential uses for undeveloped areas, i.e., parking, stormwater, camping, boat ramps/kayak launches, wildlife observation, conservation, etc.
- 3. Identify each existing structure and its condition, with recommendations for repairs and/or improvements as well as the estimated cost and potential permitting requirements.
- 4. Identify recommended new amenities including parking and stormwater requirements, estimated costs, and potential permitting requirements.
- 5. Long-term maintenance needs and estimated costs with recommendations.
- 6. Summary of findings to include immediate and long-term opportunities, risk and uncertainties, and necessary improvements associated with continued utilization of the property as a recreational amenity.

*Existing site plans for Wacissa River Park are available for review upon request.

Part 2 Potential New Acquisition:

- 1. Identify parcels within two miles of the existing Wacissa River Park suitable for acquisition as recreational amenity.
