- 4) We understand that per Section 7.6 of the RFQ (on p. 9), “The selection committee will evaluate the Proposals that are responsive to the requirements of this RFQ using the following weighted criteria listed in order of importance.” The Criteria is listed briefly in a table at the top of p. 10.
