Protestors must consult the Jefferson County Purchasing Policy for required information that must be included in the Notice of Intent to Challenge and formal written procurement challenge and for the applicable procurement challenge bond that must be submitted along with the written procurement challenge. Failure to file a Notice of Intent to Challenge and formal written procurement challenge along with the appropriate procurement challenge bond within the timeframes provided herein shall constitute a waiver of all rights granted under the Jefferson County Purchasing Policy.
