ORDINANCE NO. 2019-043019-01

AN ORDINANCE OF JEFFERSON COUNTY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY NOISE RESTRICTION ON TEMPORARY USES AND EVENTS; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORITY; PROVIDING FINDINGS; PROVIDING TEMPORARY NOISE RESTRICTION; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR COPY ON FILE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

From the Florida "Government in the Sunshine Manual", page 43, paragraph 4c: "Section 286.0105, Florida Statutes requires: 'Each board, commission, or agency of this state or of any political subdivision thereof shall include in the notice of any meeting or hearing, if notice of meeting or hearing is required, of such board, commission, or agency, conspicuously on such notice, the advice that, if a person decides to appeal any decision made by the board, agency, or commission with respect to any matter considered at such meeting or hearing, he or she will need a record of the proceedings, and that, for such purpose, he or she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings, is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.'"
