Driveway Connection Permit Application

All <u>NEW</u> road/driveway connections and driveways more than one (1) year in age that connect to a County-maintained Road shall be required to obtain a Jefferson County Road & Driveway Connection Permit. This process will ensure the Jefferson County Road Department:

- 1. Is aware of all vehicular connections to the county-maintained roadway system.
- 2. They determine if a culvert will be required at the connection to the County Road or need updated to ensure the continued function of the county road drainage system.
- 3. After installation they will inspect and determine if the culvert was installed correctly.
